Reopening of restaurants, bars and casinos: The long-awaited moment to rediscover the pleasures in life starts on 2 June

We experienced the gentle beginnings of a “return to life” on 4 May with the reopening of boutiques on Promenade Shopping Monte-Carlo, just before Thermes Marins Monte-Carlo (treatment areas, excluding the swimming pool). On 20 May, the Government of the Principality announced that restaurants, bars and gaming establishments are authorised to reopen starting on 2 June. The long-awaited moment to rediscover the pleasures in life is taking shape. Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer will be celebrating it on 2 June with the inauguration of the new Place du Casino, on the occasion of the reopening of the Café de Paris brasserie. Mada One, at One Monte-Carlo, will also open on the same date. From 5 June, the gaming rooms at Casino de Monte-Carlo and Casino Café de Paris will come back to life. Other establishments will gradually follow based on a schedule detailed below. Everything has been rethought and implemented to ensure that the most exclusive destination in Europe is also the safest.

Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer Group establishments will open gradually and safely from 2 June, with a calendar of “rediscovered pleasures”.

- **Tuesday 2 June**

Brasserie of Café de Paris Monte-Carlo and its new terrace
Inauguration of the new Place du Casino
Mada One at One Monte-Carlo

- **Wednesday 3 June**

Monte-Carlo Bay Hotel & Resort: Orange Verte, Blue Gin, Spa Cinq Mondes (except sauna and steam room) and the boutique. The Blue Bay restaurant's reopening should be announced for the **end of June**. As for the swimming pool, the lagoon, the fitness centre and sea access, their reopening will depend on obtaining a permit issued by the authorities. Note that the hotel, which has remained open since 15 March, offers room service breakfast.

- **Friday 5 June**

Casino de Monte-Carlo - reopening of the gaming rooms, terraces and Le Salon Rose restaurant
Casino Café de Paris – rooms and terrace

- **Friday 12 June**

The Grill and the Bar Américain of Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo.
The hotel, which has remained open since 15 March, offers room service breakfast.
Monte-Carlo Beach Club, reopening will depend on obtaining a permit issued by the authorities.

- **Tuesday 16 June**

Buddha Bar Monte-Carlo

- **Wednesday 24 June**

Coya Monte-Carlo

- **Friday 3 July** (date to be confirmed)

Monte-Carlo Beach Hotel

- **Wednesday 8 July** (date to be confirmed)

Hôtel Hermitage Monte-Carlo (hotel & room service)

These dates may change depending on how the situation evolves.
