Rafael Nadal is a Spanish tennis player, on the professional circuit since 2001. He was born on 3rd June 1986 in Manacor, on the island of Majorca, in the Balearic archipelago.

Number 1 ATP player, he is considered by many specialists as the best player on clay in the history of tennis and one of the best single players of all time.

He holds the record for the number of victories in major tournaments, with 10 victories to date in Monte-Carlo, 10 victories to date in Barcelona and 10 victories to date in Rolland Garros.
