In 1956, on the occasion of her wedding to Prince Rainier, dinner was served in this prestigious establishment, which prepared the wedding cake for the official reception. 20 years later, Prince Rainier and Princess Grace celebrated their wedding anniversary at Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo, this time in the intimacy of the Hotel's wine cellars. In 1974, Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo honoured with pomp the 25th anniversary of the reign of Prince Rainier.

The entire team at Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo came together to make the Princess Grace suite a completely unique experience. The Princess Grace Suite is an exceptional 910 m² Suite on two floors (7th and 8th floors of Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo), with a refined and contemporary design and spectacular surroundings offering a 180° view of the Mediterranean. With elegant curves and minimalist lines, the Princess Grace Suite emphasises contemporaneity, transparency and the nobility of the materials, which have been enhanced by craftsmen: glass, precious wood, straw marquetry, mother-of-pearl, agate panels for the interiors which exude well-being and serenity, and natural stone for the elegant and authentic outside spaces. With nearly 440 m² of outside space on two floors, the Suite offers an unparalleled setting on the Riviera: a sublime view of the Mediterranean from the terraces for a unique stay between the sky and the sea, a heated infinity pool which opens onto an adjoining outdoor lounge and a hot tub in rare granite, for an intimate and cosy experience.

The Suite also proposes a range of luxury tailor-made services, notably a team of private Clefs d'Or concierges at the entire disposition of our Suite guests to organise their stay. The teams at Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo are attached to service excellence and the experience proposed. - two bedrooms, one office, one dressing room with toilets and one dressing room per bedroom, three lounges, one living room, one dining room, one kitchen, one bathroom with bathtub, shower/steam room and sauna and one bathroom with bathtub and shower/steam room;
- Personal pick-up from the airport or heliport, 5-star suite services, welcome gifts and personalised attention;
