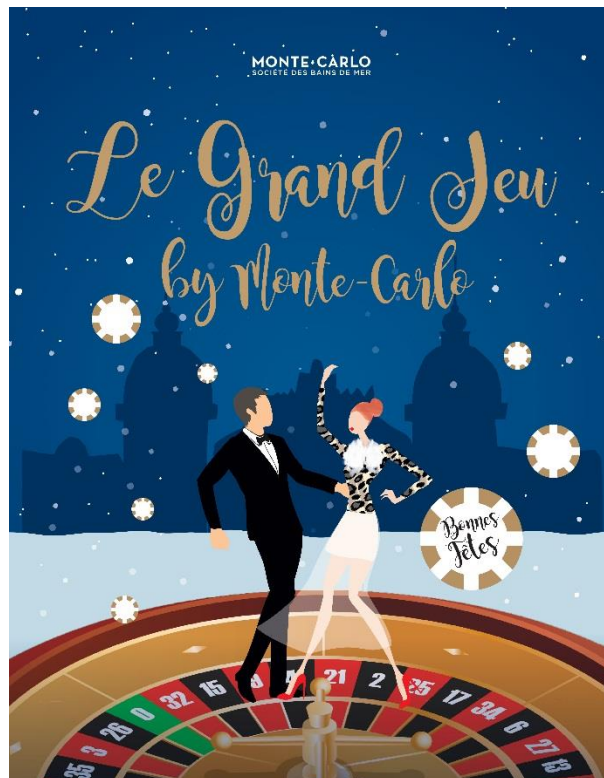

Le Grand Jeu by Monte-Carlo



The Place du Casino will once again be the place to be this winter with the grand unveiling of the revered Christmas display. Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer will showcase the festive spirit throughout the month of December, keeping the Place du Casino all decked out until 7 January 2018. This year, the chosen theme will be a creative take on the famed Place du Casino with a “Gambling” theme.

The décor of the Atrium of the Casino will set the tone with the extravagant thousand and one red and white diamond decorations for the “**Let’s Fall in Diamonds**” art installation. The Christmas scenery will be brought to life around Monaco, echoing the famed takes of Alice in Wonderland with carpets of giant cards that will wind through all the shops of the Monte-Carlo Pavilions, leading to the main square fountain, which will be transformed into a giant snowball displaying a legendary roulette wheel.
