## “Festival des Etoilés Monte-Carlo”

### New pairs of starred chefs this autumn and an exclusive evening to close the event

Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer continues its “Festival des Etoilés Monte-Carlo” with new and unique dinners concocted by pairs of star-awarded chefs in its Monaco Resort. There are three new collaborations between September and November, with the closing dinner taking place on 27 November. Save the date! It all starts on 9 September at Monte-Carlo Beach with a dinner by a female duo at Restaurant Elsa, where chef Manon Fleury will welcome star-awarded Italian chef Antonia Klugmann. The final duo dinner of the festival will bring together chef Marcel Ravin and three-starred chef Mauro Colagreco at the Blue Bay, Monte-Carlo Bay Hotel & Resort, on 5 November. To end the festival with a flourish, all of the starred chefs from SBM Resort will be preparing the closing dinner together in the Salle Médecin of Casino de Monte-Carlo on 27 November.

#### From September to November 2021: three new star-awarded pairs for a delicious start to the autumn

Boasting seven Michelin stars, Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer launched its first edition of “Festival des Etoilés Monte-Carlo” in May. The principle is simple: every month, from May to November (excluding July and August), a duo-prepared dinner is proposed in one of the star-awarded restaurants of Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer Group. #### *. 9 September: Antonia Klugmann & Manon Fleury at Restaurant Elsa, Monte- Carlo Beach*

**. 15 October: Michel Guérard & Alain Ducasse at Louis XV-Alain Ducasse à l'Hôtel de Paris**

Michel Guérard, French chef with three Michelin stars, considered a precursor of Nouvelle Cuisine with his restaurant, Les Prés d'Eugénie, will be cooking alongside Alain Ducasse. The full-on French gastronomy experience will take place over a six-starred lunch or dinner on 15 October at Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo, in the Louis XV-Alain Ducasse restaurant.

**. 5 November: Mauro Colagreco & Marcel Ravin at the Blue Bay, Monte-Carlo Bay Hotel & Resort**

Following on from the success of the four-handed dinner with Michel Sarran in May, this time Marcel Ravin has invited three-starred chef Mauro Colagreco whose Mirazur restaurant was voted best restaurant in the world in 2019. This star-awarded pair will be creating dinner with a Mediterranean theme at the Blue Bay on 5 November.
