

"The Sea Is Green", The new highlight of Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer to discover from 10 March to 10 May 2023

Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer is dedicating 2023 to The Sea, and heralds spring with a new programme of events called "The Sea Is Green". Hôtel Hermitage Monte-Carlo once again fulfils its role as a hotel for connoisseurs and a meeting place for the arts and the environment: on Saturday 11 March, the inaugural event takes place with the "Water Music" recital-dinner, accompanied by an exhibition by Jean Boghossian, a music recital by Stella Almondo and an exceptional dinner created by Yannick Alléno. Still at the Hotel for Connoisseurs, an event on 22 March on "The Sea is Green, the sustainable hotel industry and protection of the Oceans" will be part of the official programme of Monaco Ocean Week. A whole set of events will take place over this period until 10 May, focusing on art, culture and solidarity through the prism of environmental protection, with an exceptional ambassador for the occasion: Pierre Frolla, a leading figure in the commitment to the protection of the seas and oceans.

Saturday 11 March, inaugural event of "The Sea is Green" programme

At Hôtel Hermitage Monte-Carlo, the exhibition of Jean Boghossian will be presented by the artist himself. The evening will continue with a "Water Music" recital-dinner by the prodigious Monegasque planist Stella Almondo, organised in the luxurious hotel, in the winter garden, with a menu by Chef Yannick Alléno. Renowned musical journalist, David Abiker, will orchestrate the evening, which will then be broadcast on Radio Classique.

Wednesday 22 March 2023, "The Sea is Green, the sustainable hotel industry and protection of the Oceans" event

At Hôtel Hermitage Monte-Carlo, the morning will start with a visit of "The Sea is Green" exhibition, with explanations by the artist Jean Boghossian, followed by a meeting involving feedback from players in the sustainable hotel industry on what they are doing to protect the environment, questioned by the journalist Leïla Ghandi and in the presence of Pierre Frolla. This meeting is part of the official programme of *Monaco Ocean Week* organised each year by the Principality of Monaco.

From 13 March to 17 March 2023, Solidarity Week

Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer renews its commitment to the Foyer Economique de Nice as part of Solidarity Week: after the first successful edition in 2021, Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer chefs are once again teaming up with Solidarpole to help those most in need from 13 March to 17 March 2023. Wednesday 10 May 2023, a stylish ending
