Two new not-to-be-missed venues to complement COYA Monte-Carlo, Buddha-Bar Monte-Carlo and Jimmy'z Monte-Carlo, making Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer the most exclusive festive destination on the Riviera.

Latest developments in 2023: Maona Monte-Carlo, an open-air summer cabaret celebrating Monaco's heritage



From July 2023, Maona Monte-Carlo will be presenting a first in the Principality: a summer cabaret under the stars with the stunning Riviera atmosphere, reconnecting with its origins, which will highlight live music and the culinary heritage of Monaco. A villa-terrace on the rocks, close to Monte-Carlo Beach, looking onto the Mediterranean on the water's edge and gazing up to the stars, in a retro and shimmering setting, for an unforgettable festive experience combining the irreverence of the 1960s with the refinement of La Dolce Vita.



With Maona Monte-Carlo, two mythical decades are brought back to life: the 60s-70s and their breath of freedom and recklessness, embodied by the most iconic celebrities who made the Principality their summer residence. "Ma" like Maria Callas and "Ona" like Aristotle Onassis, the celebrities behind the very first Maona, created just a stone's throw away in 1962 and which opened its doors to personalities from the world of music, cinema

and business: Jerry Lewis, Joséphine Baker, Omar Sharif, Liza Minnelli, Michael Caine, Yves Montand, Sheila, Charles Aznavour, Johnny Hallyday, Arthur Ashe, and more.

In 2023, to enhance the most festive of journeys through the Monaco of then and now, between France and Italy, the music has that "Belle Epoque" vibe from the French electro music collective, Bon entendeur, known for its remixes of French-speaking songs. Every day from 7pm to 8pm a "Sunset DJ", playing sounds from France and Italy in the 1960s, will start the evening in Dolce mode. From 8pm to 2am, it's night-life time with a live piano session and a soul diva to finish on an electro-disco DJ set: from early evening and through the night, Maona Monte-Carlo will roll out its deliciously retro original soundtrack. At 9.30pm, the Diva of Maona Monte-Carlo will take centre stage: Roxane Lebrasse, Australian singer with soul, RnB and motown influences, who made it to the 2020 finals of The Voice and has taken part in tours with artists such as James Morrison, Blackstreet, Eric Bellinger, Guy Sebastian and Justice Crew.

Maona Monte-Carlo is also a restaurant that celebrates the culinary heritage of Monaco. To concoct a menu loyal to local gastronomy, Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer involved its employees, their parents and grandparents to collect the best family recipes! Thanks to their family recipes typical of the region, combined with the expertise of Christian Garcia, chef at the Prince's Palace, the menu enhances all the classics of Monaco cuisine with popular, sunny and generous dishes. The menu at Maona Monte-Carlo thus features local and sharing cuisine: barbajuans, estocaficada, socca or fougasse, king prawns flambéed in pastis, tagliolini with capon, marjoram and lemon, and a Pêche Melba in homage to the great Auguste Escoffier who marked the gastronomical history of Monaco. Homage also to the cuisine of the neighbouring Riviera towns of Portofino and Nice with focaccia, tourte de bléa or pissaladière. Passionate about the right product and local gastronomy, the Maona Monte-Carlo team has unearthed some exceptional artisans. The best chick pea flour, the finest fish, the tastiest olives from the neighbouring terraces... Maona Monte-Carlo sources the unrivalled products that make up its menu from small producers in Monaco and the hinterland.

The "Bar Sauvage" is the lounge bar at Maona Monte-Carlo, a centre of mixology dedicated to art and partying: "Sauvage", like a symbol of freedom and zest for life, a name that carries the optimism of the 1960s. As a predinner drink or after-dinner drink to crown an evening out, Bar Sauvage proposes signature cocktail creations, rare spirits such as vermouth from the 1950s-60s, or an exclusive digestive made with Monaco oranges for personalised recipes, all under the guidance of Giancarlo Mancino.



Il maestro Giancarlo Mancino is one of the most award-winning and respected bartenders in the world. After leaving his home town of Basilicata to learn the art of cocktail-making all over the world, he is now sharing the fruit of his 20 years of experience behind the bar of Bar Sauvage. His menu includes a selection of aperitivo cocktails, tap cocktails, vintage Negronis, signature cocktails from the south of France and the north-west of Italy. A true and rare delight to enjoy under the pergola on warm summer nights is an exceptional Negroni Monte-Carlo 1956, the year of the wedding of HRH Prince Rainier and Grace Kelly, combining a London dry gin from the 1950s, a 1956 Amer and an Italian vermouth from the same year.

The experience will be complete with the Tam-Tam Room, an ultra-VIP space upstairs, able to welcome around 15 VIPs, a unique place to see without being seen, in total discretion. With its original and visual vintage design, a nod to Joséphine Baker, the Tam-Tam Room is ideal for Instagram moments. Make way for freedom and recklessness for evenings spent with friends!



Maona Monte-Carlo was designed by interior designer Laurent Maugoust. An original fresco was created on site by Aurore de La Morinerie who, through the evocative power of her brush strokes, anchors the establishment's identity. She has also designed the cover of the menus and the presentation dishes. The venue also pays homage to the historical Maona through showcasing its exceptional photographic heritage: a "revival" that gives the place its soul and uniqueness!

This little paradise where life and summer are celebrated is rediscovering its original DNA to become the essential venue for festive afternoons and sunsets on the Riviera. From 12 noon until 8pm, the lounge part of the club with "sunbeds" will be the ideal place for lounging and relaxing to music. Resident DJ, Supa Ju, and her vibrant House and Deep House set will liven up summer afternoons, along with guest DJs from Thursday to Sunday, such as Sacha Muki, Siryll, Selim Sivade, Vall, Gioé and Sylvain Armand. The latter will be in charge of the "Décadanse" concept in homage to the song by Serge Gainsbourg in 1971.

Club La Vigie is also unveiling the best-kept secret in Monte-Carlo Beach since 1952: its bungalows nestled in the rock and pine forest, renamed "Love Nests", for cosy moments with loved ones or friends. These idyllic cliff side refuges, which can accommodate 4 to 6 people, offer an exceptional view of the Mediterranean and the Bay of Monaco, as well as the restaurant menu by Marcel Ravin, available all day in a protected and authentic setting. To complete the festive experience and delight the heart and taste buds of its guests, Le Club La Vigie Monte-Carlo caters for 130 people in continuous service from 12 noon until 6pm in the Lounge and restaurant, with a summer menu signed by two-star-awarded chef, Marcel Ravin. The lively and generous cuisine is coloured with summer flavours, with a decidedly creative and upmarket, yet relaxed touch, with fresh and Mediterranean dishes to share. In keeping with the principle dear to Marcel Ravin, the products have a strong local emphasis, with seasonal fruits and vegetables.

The menu includes finger food with a summer vibe, such as the typical dish of the Riviera "la bagna caude", or "olive and lobster salad". Dishes to share inspired by a variety of influences will fit perfectly into this setting, offering guests a lively and generous cuisine. A seafood fish tank is also proposed with fresh lobsters and fish of the day caught locally.

"We worked with the teams of Monte-Carlo Beach, Pascal Garrigues and Julien Vadrot on a plural, non-personal identity. My idea for this place was to be able to receive customers as if welcoming them into your home, with friends, to come and share a moment around the table, either standing up or comfortably seated in the "sunbeds", and for each person to

experience this freedom and lightness: to dance, sing, soak up this holiday atmosphere! "

In terms of design, the Bohemian-inspired décor with contemporary lines and the sea as far as the eye can see has been magnified by one of the references in the interior design of clubs and festive restaurants, from Saint-Barth to Miami, including Courcheval: Samy Chams. A radiant universe where yellow pays homage to the sun and the colours of Monte-Carlo Beach, in a cool and refined *dolce vita* feel.

Little extra: this day club, hidden from view, is easily accessed from the sea thanks to a private jetty for boats visiting the coast. There is also a shuttle to easily reach Maona Monte-Carlo to continue the evening under the stars. Ideal for customers on the move looking for new and exclusive events for the summer season.
