The third international edition of the Festival des Etoilés Monte-Carlo is a delicious invitation to discover the *lumières d'étoiles*

The Monte-Carlo Festival des Etoilés is coming back this autumn for its third edition, from 29 September to 11 November 2023.

The success of the past two years makes this new edition the gastronomic event not to miss under any circumstances. The Resort's star-awarded chefs are organising four-handed meals, inviting well-known international chefs to join them to share their talent.

It starts off with chef Marcel Ravin, who welcomes French chef Julien Royer, based in Singapore, for exceptional dinners on 29 and 30 September. Then, on 13 and 14 October, the dinners will be organised at the Grill at Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo by chef Dominique Lory and British chef Jason Atherton. Still at Hôtel de Paris, chef Amaury Bouhours from Le Meurice in Paris will be joining his mentor, Alain Ducasse, for a four-hand dinner with his friend Emmanuel Pilon, on 27 and 28 October at Louis XV-Alain Ducasse. On 3 November, chef Yannick Alléno welcomes triple-awarded Swiss chef Sven Wassmer at Pavillon Monte-Carlo de l'Hôtel Hermitage to close this delicious series of meetings.

The closing gala on 11 November 2023 will take place in the Salle Empire on Place du Casino in Hôtel de Paris, with all the starred chefs of Monte-Carlo SBM Group, for a dinner to spotlight their seven stars.
