The 4th edition of the Monte-Carlo Festival des Etoilés: Tribute to the 150th anniversary of the Hôtel de Paris Cellars

The Monte-Carlo Festival des Etoilés is coming around again for the fourth time, starting on 20 April 2024 and running until October. After three superb autumn editions, the biggest gourmet event in Monaco is extending to start in the spring. Based on the same principle as previous years, the star-studded chefs at the Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer Resort remain faithful to the tradition of 4-handed meals, inviting major award-winning chefs of international renown for an original culinary experience. The 2024 edition, resonating with the celebrations for the 150th anniversary of the Hôtel de Paris Cellars, will shine the spotlight on oenology. The closing gala set for October will once again be the apotheosis of the Festival, with a new and exceptional format.

A Monte-Carlo Festival des Etoilés taking place over a longer period

With 25 restaurants and bars and over 150 years of expertise in the Art of Living, the Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer Resort has seven Michelin stars, the most for any resort in Europe. Once again this year, its star-studded chefs invite their international peers to offer fine diners moments of pure gourmet prowess around menus specially created for the occasion.

It kicks off on 20 April, at Louis XV-Alain Ducasse à l'Hôtel de Paris***, for a multi-starred duo formed for the occasion by Chef Alain Ducasse and Simon Rogan, a British chef whose restaurant L'Enclume in the United Kingdom has been awarded three stars. This exceptional duo is inviting you to both lunch and dinner.

On 11 May, Chef Marcel Ravin will welcome David Toutain, a French chef crowned with two Michelin stars and the Green star in Paris, in his new setting at Blue Bay Marcel Ravin**.

Then, to celebrate summer's arrival, Chef Dominique Lory will hold two dinners at Le Grill* at Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo on 21 & 22 June, alongside another major French chef: Yoan Conte, two-time star winner at his Table in Annecy.

Finally, after the summer break, the Festival will start up again on 14 and 15 September. Chef Yannick Alléno will welcome an American Chef with two stars to the Pavyllon Monte-Carlo*. Richard Lee will fly across the Atlantic for two exceptional dinners.

An even more exceptional closing gala in tribute to the 150th anniversary of the Hôtel de Paris Cellars

This year, the traditional closing Gala will be held in October, in the intimate setting of the Patio of Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo. The star-awarded chefs at Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer, along with their teams, will once again make the Group's know-how and gourmet tradition shine for a exceptional seven star dinner.

What would an exceptional meal be with the accompanying wines?

This 4th edition of the Monte-Carlo Festival des Etoilés will pay tribute to one of the most impressive treasures of Monegasque heritage: the Hôtel de Paris Cellars. Thanks to Marie Blanc, this veritable underground labyrinth has been home to a treasure trove of more than 350,000 bottles and vintages for 150 years, making this unique location the biggest hotel cellars in the world. The Festival will place some of the most impressive bottles in the limelight, chosen with care by the Chefs Sommeliers at Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer, and the talent of the star-studded chefs at the Resort, for perfect food and wine pairings.
