The pontoon at Monte-Carlo Beach Club has had a makeover, and the new Kids Club by Petit VIP tailors the Beach experience to children.

It's the start of a new era for Monte-Carlo Beach, driven by René Blino

René Blino has joined Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer Group as Director, taking over from Danièle Garcelon, who is passing on the torch after a long and distinguished career.

René Blino has excelled in the luxury and niche hotel sector in Bangkok, Paris, Cannes, Kuala Lumpur and Courchevel. He comes straight from Paris, where he opened and managed the Madame Rêve hotel, known particularly for its two Michelinstarred restaurant. Well-versed in the new expectations of ultra-luxury guests, he will take up the challenge of keeping alive and developing the legend of this iconic Riviera hotel and its famous club, inaugurated in 1928. He has held several management positions in the human resources, accommodation and catering sectors, for prestigious international hotel chains. On the strength of this background and experience, René Blino is now Director of Monte-Carlo Beach and launched the 2024 season of the palace on 5 April, before launching that of the Club on 12 April.

Marcel Ravin takes over the Elsa gastronomic restaurant



On 6 April 2024, the Elsa restaurant reopened under the leadership of Marcel Ravin, two-starred chef at Blue Bay Marcel Ravin restaurant, just a stone's throw away.

For the 2024 season, the Elsa restaurant, which is like a balcony overlooking the sea, inaugurates a new concept, "Jardin Marin", invented by the chef. In fact it's more than a concept; it's a tribute to the Mediterranean, both sea and land. Originally from the island of Martinique, Marcel Ravin retains a deep respect for fishing and maritime culture. His unique and committed culinary universe is largely inspired by marine life, with delicacy and creativity, and his adopted land, the Mediterranean. The menu for Elsa by Marcel Ravin boldly combines the flavours of the sea and this sun-drenched land. It is part of an approach that is increasingly responsible and loyal to the values of Elsa, which gives pride of place to local produce. This strengthens collaboration with local producers, such as Domaine d'Agerbol. Waste reduction is always a major concern, together with protecting marine resources.

On 21 March 2024, the restaurant signed the Mr. Goodfish charter, which promotes more responsible consumption of seafood, both in terms of species and seasonality, to avoid over-exploiting resources. Monte-Carlo Beach also has Green Globe Platinum certification.
