## In Monte-Carlo, flowers grow and streets glow

They haven't gone unnoticed: the elegant wild rose sculptures have bloomed on Place du Casino and throughout the Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer Resort. Designed by artist Céline Pagès, who "sprinkled Monte-Carlo with poetry" these giant brass flowers, ranging from 2 to 3.5 meters in height, are adorned in powder pink, gold, mint green, ivory, and bright pink. Stunning structures that seek "the purity of form and the energy of the flower" all while respecting the environment. All materials used by the artist are entirely non-polluting and will be recycled.
