



Jondal à La Vigie Monte-Carlo, The Joy of Living made in Ibiza arrives at Monte-Carlo Beach

News Flash - Monaco, June 27, 2025 – On Saturday, June 21, Monte-Carlo Beach unveiled its latest gem. Following the brand-new restaurant Le Deck, the newly Michelin-starred Elsa, the Greek-inspired Maona – *From Mykonos to Monte-Carlo*, and the Jacquemus pop-up, Monte-Carlo Beach completes its transformation for the 2025 season with Jondal at La Vigie Monte-Carlo. A concept straight from Ibiza, the Jondal restaurant settles into the idyllic setting of La Pointe de la Vigie. Mediterranean cuisine shines here, perfect for sun-soaked lunches or starlit dinners, all in a spirit of sharing and conviviality. As a backdrop, the endless sea offers a timeless escape.

Monte-Carlo Beach continues to surprise us this season. Since June 21, a brand-new venue has nestled by the sea, under the pines of La Pointe de la Vigie, a site classified as an LPO (Bird Protection League) refuge: Jondal à La Vigie Monte-Carlo. Imported from the Balearic Islands – more precisely from Ibiza – this concept is the brainchild of the talented Spanish chef Rafa Zafra, who trained notably at the world-famous El Bulli, and it's all about one key principle: The Joy of Living. Since its debut in Spain in 2020, this ultra-exclusive venue has been consistently in demand, quickly establishing itself as a must-visit address.

Now, Jondal and the Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer Group are partnering to launch Jondal at La Vigie Monte-Carlo, for a two-month summer prelude. An almost-secret location where the only soundtrack is laughter, birdsong, and the gentle lapping of waves.

Here, the Mediterranean art de vivre is savored between sea and sky, with seafood and fish taking center stage, offered in a variety of preparations (grilled, raw, fried, and more). As evening falls, the magic of the place is heightened by the glow of twilight.

With Jondal à La Vigie, Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer further asserts its position as a leading gastronomic destination. A rare and exceptional interlude, available for just two months at Monte-Carlo Beach.
