Children will follow the adventures of five adorable reindeer: Flocon, Rose, Hercule, Stella, and Rudolph, Santa's loyal companion. Santa Claus will also visit the Place du Casino with his traditional choir on December 20, 21, 24, and 25, from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. On the façade of the Casino de Monte-Carlo, a sound and light show will feature the little reindeer every 30 minutes between 6 p.m. and 10 p.m. each weekend in December, and then every day during the school holidays.

The magic continues from the Place du Casino along Avenue des Beaux-Arts, Allée François Blanc, and One Monte-Carlo, with the Promenade Shopping Monte-Carlo boutiques open every day in December (except the 25th).
