He then moved to Doha, where he supported the opening of a Park Hyatt in the Middle East as Director of Operations. After the health crisis, he returned to the French Riviera as Hotel Manager of the Martinez in Cannes, where he oversaw the first post-Covid season, marked by a major operational reorganization.

He was subsequently appointed General Manager of the Hyatt Regency Nice Palais de la Méditerranée, where he successfully led the renovation of the restaurant, launched a repositioning project, and achieved record revenue levels in 2022.

Since 2023, Guillaume Ranvier had served as Hotel Manager of the Four Seasons Hotel George V in Paris, an iconic property of the Group, where he helped strengthen a culture of excellence focused on performance, team cohesion, and the quality of the guest experience.

Through this rich international journey, Guillaume Ranvier has developed strong values of rigor and excellence, along with a passion for a demanding profession.
