



Monopoly Game and Café Rotonde: the Casino de Monte-Carlo reinvents itself

News Flash - Monaco, April 16, 2026 – A mythical establishment of the Principality of Monaco since 1863, the Casino de Monte-Carlo continues to innovate and surprise its clientele. In 2026, the renowned gaming venue is giving a fresh new look to its Atrium, with a revamped offering at the Café Rotonde, as well as a décor paying tribute to the Monopoly game, combined with the arrival of new themed slot machines, which will be unveiled this Friday evening during a dedicated event.

A giant game board, a few tokens, carefully arranged houses and hotels, a bundle of banknotes falling from the sky... the famous board game Monopoly is making its way into the Atrium of the Casino de Monte-Carlo, under the watchful eye of an impressive 3-meter-tall Mr. Monopoly. Until May 17, 2026, players and visitors are invited to discover this brand-new décor. But the magic doesn't stop there: following the success of the launch of the exclusive Monopoly Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer edition last December, players are now invited to attend, as a European premiere, the launch of the new Monopoly Big Board Bucks slot machines by Aristocrat Gaming, this Friday, April 17, at 7:30 PM. The event will take place at the Casino de Monte-Carlo, in the Salle Renaissance, for a special evening in the presence of Mr. Monopoly himself. Eight slot machines will be unveiled; four of them will join the Casino Café de Paris on April 20, which is also preparing its share of surprises for players. Until May 17, all members of the MyMonteCarlo program will be able to try their luck to win more than 8,000 prizes, representing €100,000 in gifts. The thrill of the game will also continue on social media starting April 20, with "Mr. Monopoly's Riddle," available on the Instagram account [@casinocafédeparis](#). A prize draw will select three lucky winners among the correct answers, offering exclusive prizes.

A benchmark of the Grand Art of Gaming as well as the Grand Art of Living, the Casino de Monte-Carlo is also expanding the Café Rotonde offering. Now open from 10 AM to 8 PM with continuous service, and newly decorated with authentic slot machines from the 1930s, the Café Rotonde now offers, in addition to its savory menu, a selection of delicious pastries to enjoy on-site, inspired by the world of gaming. Among them are three exclusive creations imagined by the Pastry Division of Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer: the Tuxedo (72% dark chocolate crémeux and choux pastry), the Lucky Dice (runny Piedmont hazelnut center, soft biscuit, and light praline cream), the Playing Card (caramelized puff pastry, tonka whipped cream, and local raspberries). A delicious selection of hot and cold beverages, including signature cocktails such as the Jackpot Monkey (Monkey 47 Gin, Italicus, ginger syrup, grapefruit juice, grapefruit bitters, ginger beer, and chamomile infusion), the Lucky Calabrese (Italicus, grapefruit juice, mandarin syrup, and Mumm Champagne), and the Four Aces (Ketel One Vodka, lime & lemon marmalade, pineapple juice, grapefruit juice, grapefruit bitters, and cinnamon syrup), perfectly complements the tasting experience. For more than 160 years, now more than ever, the Casino de Monte-Carlo remains the ultimate symbol of the Grand Art of Living.
