A showcase for Monaco’s most glamorous nights, Sporting Monte-Carlo also joins the celebration, with COYA Monte-Carlo hosting four evenings where Peruvian flavors meet DJ Carmine Sorrentino’s beats.

Jimmy’s Monte-Carlo unveils an exceptional line-up: on April 25, American rapper Quavo will take over the venue during the Monaco Historic Grand Prix. For the Formula One Louis Vuitton Grand Prix, the club turns up the volume with Mike Will Made It (June 4), Hugel (June 5), Fisher & Philipp Plein (June 6), and Black Coffee (June 7).
