## Discover the 2026 programme of Hôtel Hermitage Monte-Carlo, Hotel for Connoisseurs

After a launch marked by the very first edition of Monaco Poetry Night and Day, on 26 and 27 March, orchestrated by Thierry Consigny, and with the exceptional participation of actor Lambert Wilson, the summer will be punctuated by other fine cultural events at Hôtel Hermitage Monte-Carlo.
