The 50 Best Hotels 2026: Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo Once again named one of the world's finest hotels

Press Release – Monaco, September 16, 2026 – Once again this year, Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo, a jewel in Monaco's hotel industry, has been named to the prestigious 50 Best Hotels list, which ranks the 50 finest hotels in the world. The 50 Best 2026 ceremony took place in Paris on Tuesday, September 15.

The leading professionals in tourism and luxury hospitality gathered on September 15 at the Salles du Carrousel in Paris for the ceremony marking the fourth edition of the 50 Best Hotels 2026. The world's fifty best hotels were unveiled, with Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo ranking 40th.

Louis Starck, General Manager of Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo, attended the ceremony alongside Vincent Chasseignaux, Hotel Manager.

Already recognized by La Liste 2026, which ranks the 1,000 best hotels in the world, last summer, Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo has once again confirmed the commitment to Excellence that defines it. Built in 1864, the Monaco palace, with its Belle Époque architecture, is a true jewel of the hotel industry.

Ideally located on Place du Casino, near Casino de Monte-Carlo, Thermes Marins Monte-Carlo and Opéra Monte-Carlo, the hotel is home to four Michelin stars, awarded to Le Louis XV-Alain Ducasse*** and Le Grill*.

A rich gastronomic offering is complemented by Em Sherif Monte-Carlo and its Lebanese flavors, Le Bar Américain and its glamorous jazz atmosphere, as well as Cedric Grolet Monte-Carlo and its original, indulgent creations in the heart of the Patio.

Renovated in 2019 after five years of work, the hotel features 206 rooms and suites, including exceptional Diamond Suites such as the Diamond Suite Prince Rainier III and the Diamond Suite Princesse Grace. Lastly, the Caves de l'Hôtel de Paris, built in 1874 at a depth of 12 meters, house more than 300,000 bottles and more than 11,000 references across 1,500 m². The world's largest hotel wine cellars, they received the "Best of Award of Excellence" from *Wine Spectator's* 2026 in June 2026, attesting to the quality and depth of the wines stored there.

This latest distinction awarded to Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo once again recognizes all the work carried out every day by the palace and its teams, for more than 160 years.
